Scholarship Origins

Since the inception of The American Legion Legacy Scholarship in 2001 following the Sept. 11 terrorist attacks, The American Legion has



offered its support to the children of fallen post-9/11 servicemembers through this scholarship. Beginning with the

2017 award year, The American Legion expanded the scholarship to include children of VA-rated, post-9/11 veterans with a combined disability rating of 50 percent or higher. Our organization remains committed to honoring the memory and service of our fallen and disabled comrades by ensuring their children are afforded the best possible educational opportunities.

Department of Missouri American Legion Riders

2021 was the seventh year that the Legion Riders of Missouri conducted their three-day, state-wide Legacy Scholarship Run. The ride stopped at American Legions and Veteran's memorials along the route, receiving donations along the way. \$86,200 was collected in 2021, with 100% of those proceeds being passed on the Legacy Scholarship Fund. There are no operating costs associated with the fund.

About the Legacy Scholarship Fund

The total amount of Legacy Scholarship money to be awarded varies based on the amount of donations received each year and the total amount of income derived from interest on the trust each year. Fifty percent of each amount is made available for awards each year – beginning with the 2017 award year. Each award made is good for one year and may be up to \$20,000. The average amount for each scholarship in 2019 was \$19,695 per student. The amount of each award is determined by

the financial need of that student as determined by fiscal information provided by the applicant during the application process. Depending on the amount of total money available for award, the number of appli-

cants and the total need in a given year, all applicants might not receive an award. However, The American Legion will strive to offer as many awards as possible.
